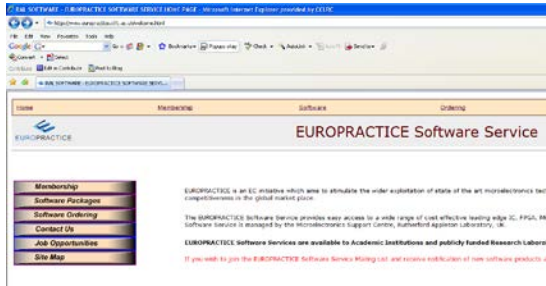

Usage is limited to staff and students of the End User and only at the premises of the End User. End Users will also be required to complete additional documentation at the request of some EUROPRACTICE vendors.

With a few exceptions, EUROPRACTICE orders are mostly processed on a once per month bulk licence order to each vendor and the deadline for receipt of all order paperwork (paper originals of legal agreements included) is the 25th day of each month. All EUROPRACTICE Financial Transactions are made in EUROS. New members (and in certain cases existing members) will be expected to pay for design tool orders in advance of receiving licences.
